- 2. The fine hair cannot be woven on machines and so weavers of Kashmir make these shawls by hand. This is a long and difficult process. After almost 250 hours of weaving, one plain Pashmina shawl is made.
- 3. Many families in Srinagar live in a 'Donga'. These boats can be seen in Dal Lake and Jhelum river. From inside the 'Donga' is just like a house with different rooms. Some old houses have a special type of window which comes out of the wall.
- 4. In the language of the Changpa 'Changthang' means a place where very few people live.
