Two Sikh players on the Indian team, Amritpal Singh and Amijot Singh, were asked to remove their turbans before the start of their opening game against Japan. The players refused, and the match was postponed for over an hour.

The incident sparked a global outcry, and FIBA eventually reversed its decision, allowing the players to wear their turbans. The Indian team went on to win the game against Japan, and the "Turban Incident" is now seen as a landmark moment in the fight for religious freedom in sports.
