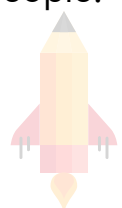

branches	:- The parts of a tree that grow out from the trunk.
lizards	:- Small reptiles with scales and tails.
bicycle	:- A vehicle with two wheels that you ride by pushing pedals with your feet.

B. Tell your classmates about the fun you had on your way to school.

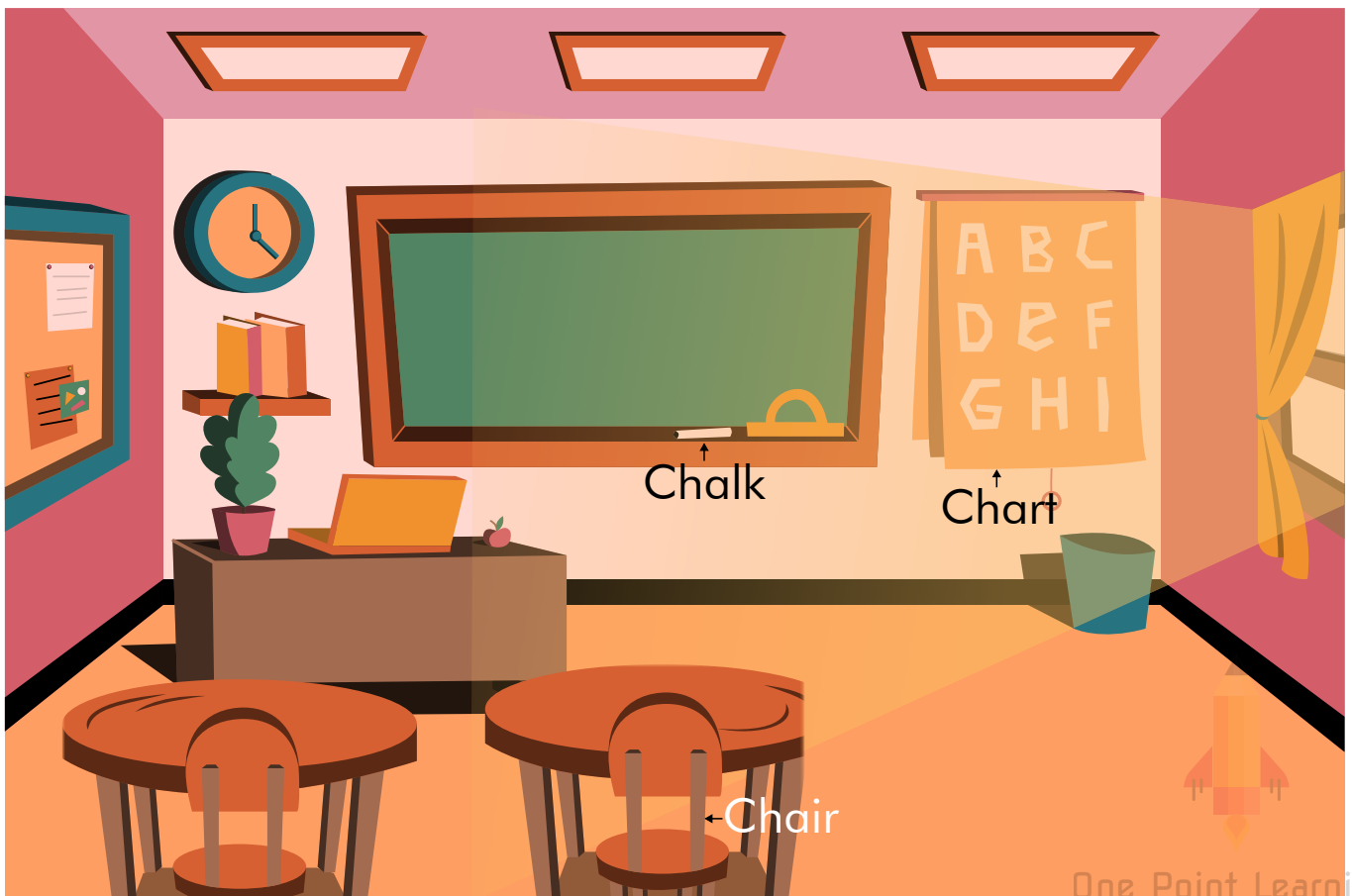

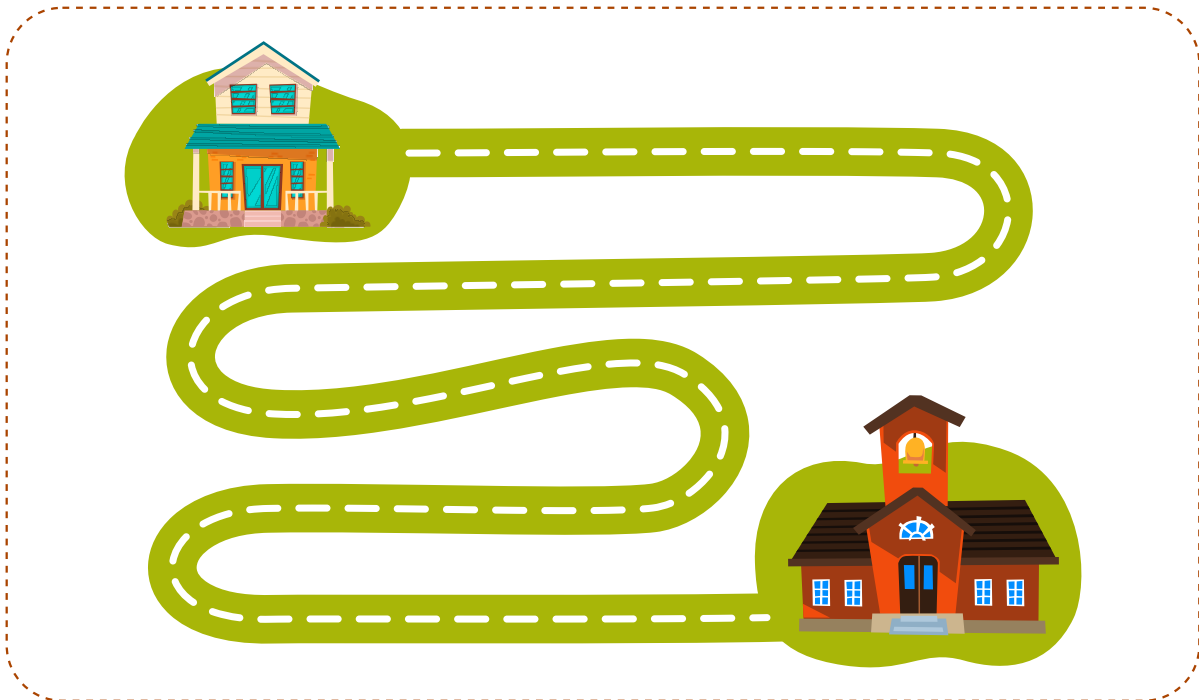
