New words

climb	:- To go up something, like a tree or stairs.
leap	:- To jump very high or very far.
Swim	:- To move through water.
trot	:- How a horse runs, a bit slower than very fast.
Fly	:- To move through the air, like a bird or a plane.

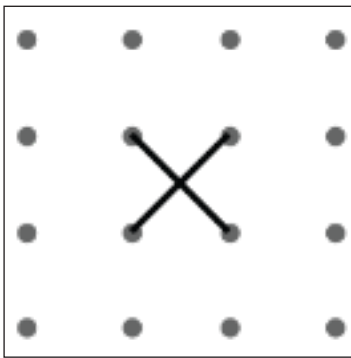

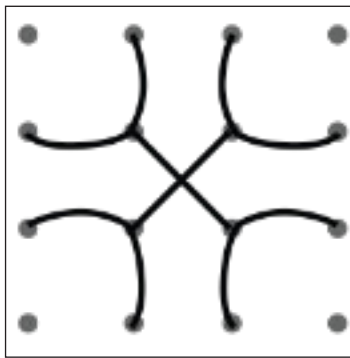
Rangoli

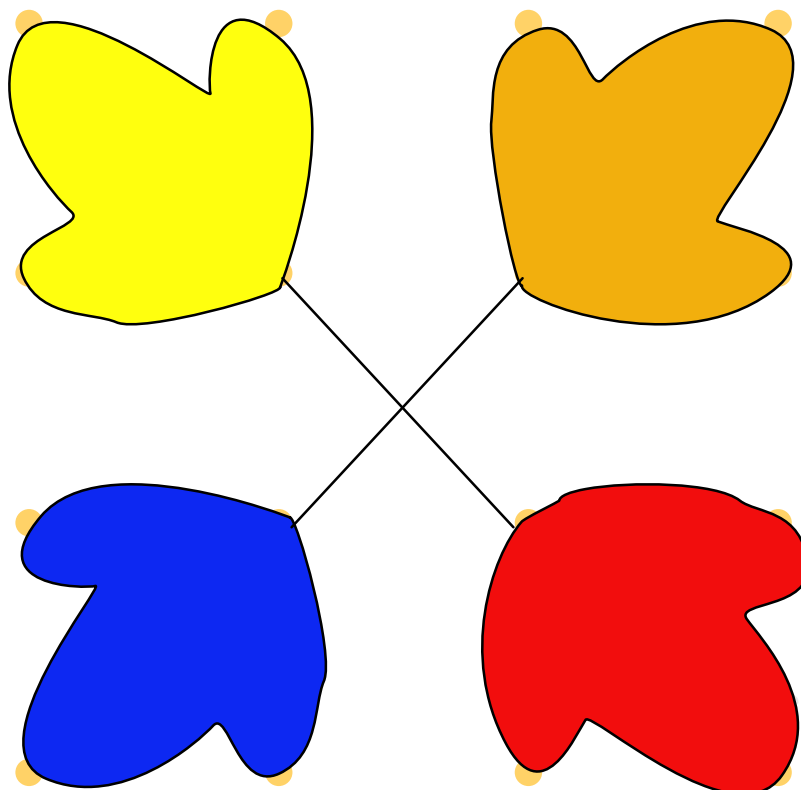
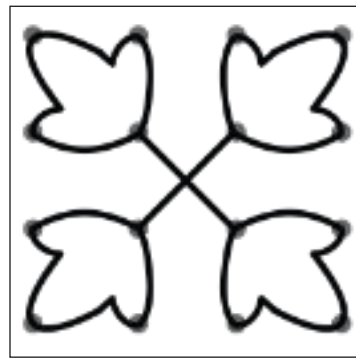
